## How to insert Micro-SIM card and connect the battery

- 1. Gently remove MSP500 cover using plastic pry tool from both sides.
- Insert Micro-SIM card as shown with PIN request disabled or read <u>Security info</u> how to enter it later in <u>Teltonika Configurator</u>. Make sure that Micro-SIM card cut-off corner is pointing forward to slot.
- 3. Connect **battery** as shown to device. Position the battery in place where it does not obstruct other components.
- 4. After configuration, see "<u>PC Connection (Windows)</u>", attach device cover back.

Device is ready to be installed.

#### ××××

Micro-SIM card insertion/removal must be performed when device is powered off -★ external voltage and internal battery disconnected. Otherwise Micro-SIM card might be damaged or device will not detect it.
